

How to Download an ebook from the Wisconsin Public Library Consortium (WPLC) onto your Windows PC Computer

1) On the MORE online catalog (<http://www.more.lib.wi.us>), click on Digital Downloads to go to the Wisconsin Public Library Consortium website (<http://dbooks.wplc.info>)



2) Find an available ebook. Browse **Currently Available ebooks** to find something available immediately.

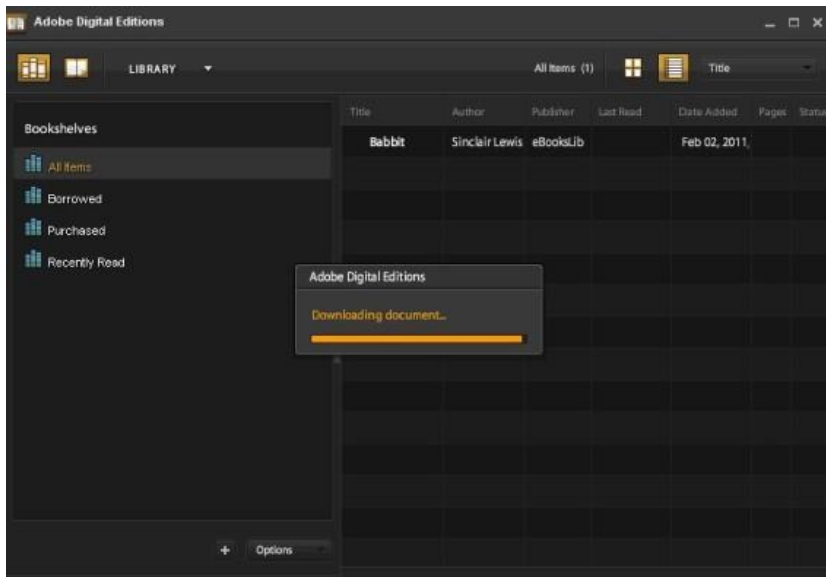

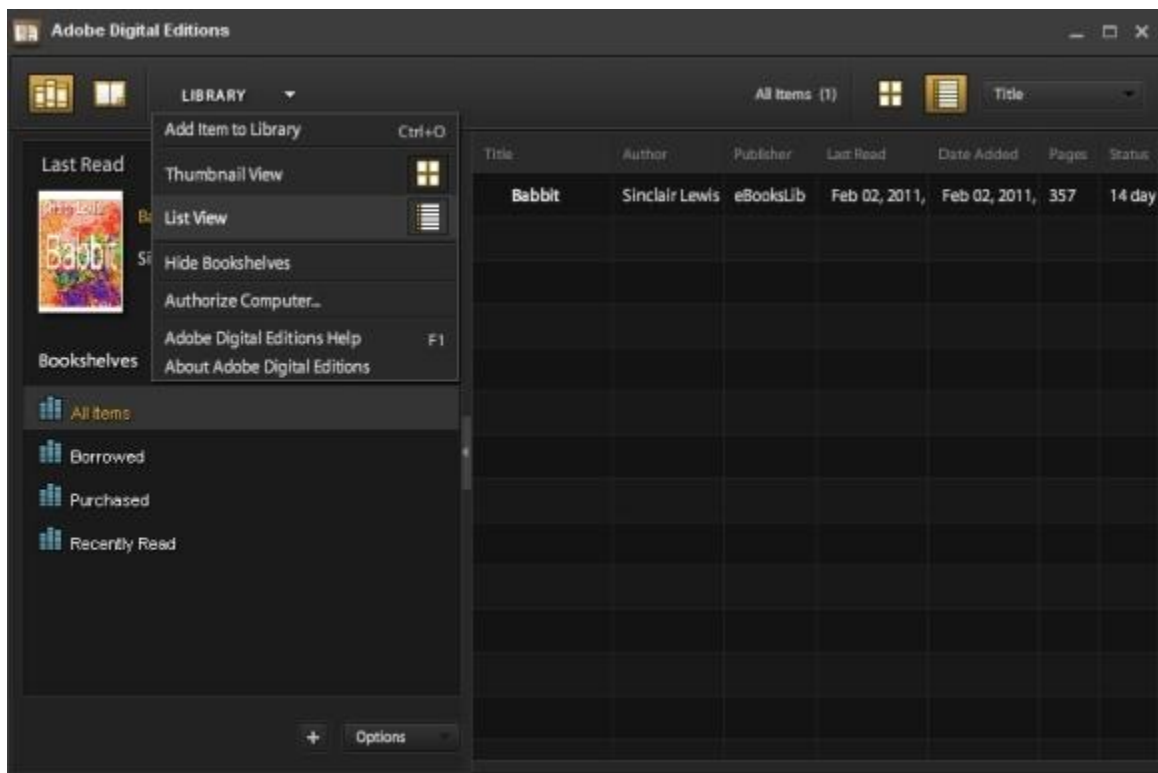
9) The Adobe Digital Editions program will open and download the ebook.



10) When your ebook is done downloading, you will see the ebook in Adobe Digital Editions. You can begin reading your ebook on your Windows PC computer.



11) Click on **Library** for other views and options.



12) If you are on a shared computer, **Sign Out** of the Wisconsin Public Library Consortium (WPLC) Digital Downloads web site when you are done.
